



## FileMaker Pro 17.0.3 Advanced Release Notes

This software updates FileMaker Pro 17 Advanced to version 17.0.3, addresses known issues in macOS Mojave 10.14, and fixes bugs.

### Software details

The following issues were addressed.

**Important:** To ensure that you don't encounter the issues below, you must update all clients to FileMaker Pro 17.0.3 Advanced.

### Application

- Windows: The application could stop responding when initializing custom menus.
- Windows: The application closed unexpectedly when the Script Workspace was maximized and then restored to its previous size after the script steps pane was displayed.

### Layouts

- Improved performance when drawing layouts that don't contain portals used for master-detail layouts.

### macOS Mojave 10.14

- There was a graphical problem in some Edit dialog boxes.
- The operators list in the Specify Calculation dialog box did not display
